Classes Beginning the Week of August 24, 2008

The Pentateuch

This course is a study of the background and content of the first five books of the Old Testament. Emphasis will be given to the historical setting and literary background of this portion of Scripture as well as how this part of Scripture plays a part in the believer's life.

Time: 6:00–9:00 PM , Tuesdays

Christian Doctrines

This course presents an analysis of the basic concepts of Christian thought from the Biblical to contemporary era. Emphasis will be placed on the consideration of the essential doctrines of the Christian faith under such categories as God, Man, Sin, Redemption, the Christian Life, and Eschatology.

Time: 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM , Wednesdays

The Life and Literature of Paul

This course will be the study of the ministry of Paul, the greatest missionary and most influential theologian of the Christian faith. Students will examine Paul's influence in the spread of Christianity including his relationship to the ministry of Christ and to Jewish and Greco-Roman thought.
